Establishing Relationship between Blood Groups and IQ in Population of Some Areas of Rural and Urban Punjab, India

Abstract: It has been established through various studies that there is a relationship between inheritance of blood groups and Intelligence Quotient in individuals. In this study survey was done of 263 people of Rural Punjab (including males and females) and 367 people of Urban Punjab (including males and females). All the individuals were made to solve a "Standard Progressive Matrices" by Raven et. al. According to the score they were categorized. It was found that in rural area , males with blood group O show high IQ level. These are intellectually superior. The average and below average individuals are found to be having predominantly blood group B and females of rural areas with high IQ are found to be having blood group O. The females with average IQ are found to be having blood group B. In urban areas , males with high, average and below average IQ are found to be having blood group O followed by blood group B. Whereas, females of urban area with high and low IQ level are found to be having blood group B.
